The Colour Group (Great Britain)

Application for WD Wright or Palmer Award

The Colour Group presents financial awards to assist students who are keen to travel and participate in conferences in the fields of art, colour science and colour imaging. There are two sets of awards, each made in alternate years:

- The **WD Wright** award, in all fields, intended primarily for Post Graduate students and made in even calendar years.
- The **Palmer** award, in colour science and colour imaging, intended for both Post Graduate students and Post Doctoral Fellows (or equivalent) and made in odd calendar years.

Each award is for an amount up to £500.

Applicants must be enrolled at a University or College in the UK. There are no restrictions on nationality or age.

Awards will not be made in the year following a successful award for the same or essentially the same work.

It is expected that conference registration fees will be paid by the university/college.

Successful candidates will be announced at the Annual General Meeting of the Colour Group in May.

Successful candidates will be invited to present their papers at a meeting of the Colour Group, usually held on the first Wednesday of November. Reasonable expenses to attend this meeting will be paid.

Applications should be made on the Application Form on the next page by the date shown below.

Officers and Committee Members of the Colour Group (Great Britain) are not eligible for any award.
